## Introduction

This is my first blog -

It is very important that this section should not be used for hypotheses and speculation as there are other areas of the VUFOA site for personal views. Many people will see the same event differently from others due to different cultural influences.

To remain concise or efficient, only known facts and accurate descriptions of events – even potential misinterpretations, at or immediately after the time of viewing should be included, however short in time or detail. In my own sighting in 1978, I had up to 8 seconds to view very accurate details of lights in the night sky. A good memory for exact detail helps significantly!

Research must be done by contributors before submitting articles or basic information. It is easy to verify 'trusted' facts on the Internet by typing key words into search engines. References – and contacts with 'trusted' authors, from other sites must always be given at the bottom of articles so other people can do their own research.

This is the most effective way that people can learn – and limit the amount of paperwork I will have to do! Each author only deals with a minimum of one person – themselves, but I might have to deal with anything up to hundreds of VUFOA members – and hundreds of witnesses and investigators in the future.

Subjects should be related in any way to ufology, but they can also have descriptions that appear to be like other objects or experiences. If something is shaped like a crescent Moon or moves like a balloon in a changing wind flow, then that will be important to an investigation or report.

## Lights in the Sky (30 December, 1978)

About 11.00pm (Tasmanian Summer Time or Daylight Saving Time, 10.00pm Australian Eastern Standard Time and 1200 Coordinated Universal Time) on 30 December 1978, two sets of three bright star-sized lights, each in a close-knit triangle, flew on horizontal trajectories over the Tasman Sea, taking about ten seconds to cover the full extent of the horizon as viewed from Princes Wharf 1 in Hobart, Tasmania.

The first set flew in a SSE direction, taking a few seconds to travel from a point directly above my head, and away from my direction of viewing, until I could no longer see it, but I can't remember if it simply faded with distance. The second set followed in a SSW direction a few seconds later – about the time the first one decreased in visibility. It crossed the path of the first set to create an X like a game of Noughts And Crosses in the black, night sky.

This was several days after the first UFO sighting in New Zealand on 21 December 1978, and about the same time as the plane flight, which carried a New Zealand television crew on 30 December 1978. Their story appeared on national television as well as other forms of electronic and printed media!

A friend who was with me at the very noisy and bright Hobart summer festival, which included sideshows, flatly refused to look at what I was telling him about, and kept his eyes firmly on me! Who could blame him? This incident was the beginning of a now very-long hobby in ufology! Someone south of Hobart also made a report of one, the other or both lights, which headed in that direction after passing over Hobart. I don't know which.

This incident may have been an obsession for the first two days, but I still had my existing life to live!

I still have my very detailed personal investigation on two double-sided foolscap sheets of paper, but will probably never discover what these rapid sets of controlled lights in a triangle were. I noticed the second set as having two static, white, star-sized lights on top, and one slightly dimmer, possibly yellowish light underneath, which pulsated slightly at about one cycle per second. I had five seconds to notice the second one, and eight seconds to notice both!

The velocities and arrangements of these two sets of lights still baffle me when I try to match them to any aircraft that is familiar to me. Two days later, a local television news reporter said they were "light aircraft", but I know better, having worked out different speeds at different altitudes for different aircraft types! Nothing matched what I saw!

Who is this contact for Tasmania who is 'alien' to the Australian state of Victoria?

None other than the Librarian for the Tasmanian UFO Investigation Centre (TUFOIC). That was formed in October 1965, but I have only been in it since the 1980s, having seen my first unidentifiable pair of UFOs in December 1978.

My first 'UFO' was a trail of white smoke about 1963, but much more recently, I read about that as being an American test plane called the X-15, I think it is called. I have also had an interest in aliens for that long, but I still haven't met anyone who has claimed to be one!

Since my early childhood, I have loved to pull things apart to see how they worked. Not only that, I have also been rarely satisfied with the way in which commercial products operated, so I started building my own equipment in 1964. I also became a model-maker then, but it wasn't until the early part of the 21st Century that I labelled myself as the "Master of Modification".

However, I quite often need instruction and repair manuals to work out what something is supposed to do, especially when it doesn't because of minor faults – or a complete breakdown! A great deal of equipment has either been returned to over-hopeful owners or is now on the tip!

More of it clogs my sheds, but more still has been thrown out! I just don't need to repair most things now.

One of the things that hasn't worked properly is modern society because of its refusal of the overall acknowledgement of the existence of UFOs and aliens! Like all things that I come in contact with, I feel the need to rectify situations to suit my own curiosity. Being a compassionate person, I do not like people in high places treading on us little people!

In December 1988, I began teaching myself industrial design for the community to the point where my persistence has put me in a very privileged position. I have basic University experience in a wide range of fields, but have never studied in a full capacity! Science has been my first love since I was introduced to astronomy in Grade 5 in 1962.

People from all walks of life – from Government departments, businesses and private organisations right down to children have asked to me fix something in their lives.

That often leads to equipment I have never seen before, and have no repair manuals to assist in understanding what is supposed to happen. We all have our limits and can't help people who expect more than what we have been taught.

### Now See Here!

As no one can ever see or feel an event in the same way as someone else, that is how I will present this article. There may be times when people think they do – especially regarding mental telepathy or genetic make-up, but deep down inside, no two people are alike!

Time – especially in duration more than chronology, can feature prominently in interpreting or misinterpreting an event. So can light levels, along with the usual education in schools, their different systems, religions and upbringing by parents, guardians, nannies, siblings and friends – or none of these! People see life differently, which results in different interpretations of events.

For me, something I thought I saw a few seconds ago does not always turn out to be the same a few seconds later! Having thought for a long time about this, I can only theorise using well over 50 years of extensive self-taught education!

Science has been my first obsession since I was introduced to it in primary school, but what I really wanted to know was either unknown to – and ignored by teachers at that time or was because there was no one else except my older brother who was willing to spend a lot of time sharing his acquired knowledge! Early in our childhoods, he became a 'maths freak', but I became a 'science freak'.

I tell people that I had a weird childhood because I had experiences that medieval village residents would have burned me at the stake for! However, I will only concentrate here on interpretations of my present physiology – like eyes and brain, for example.

Sometimes, I don't react when people approach me because they are standing between me and a source of light – usually daylight through a doorway or the Sun. Anyone who has a camera has experienced this many times where the background is brightly lit and the subject is facing away from the light, causing a shadow to appear on one side of them, usually the front with their face.

This is demonstrated in this number (**8**8), where the 'person' outside the doorway and farther back (on the right) is illuminated from the front and the 'other' (inside the doorway) on the right is illuminated from the back, causing a shadow. This has also happened for me in the open flap of a large tent where one person was just outside. The sky provided the backdrop to this 'shadow of a man'.

Flashbacks can return me to my past for a few seconds or more, given my amazing deep memory for certain events, but that doesn't necessarily mean I'm special in any way – this is just another human trait, which many people don't understand. It frightens some, but there is no need to feel that way! It's just the way our very unimaginably complicated brains work! It's no wonder present Earth science has not been able to artificially reproduce one!

Back to my eyes! There are floaters inside the human eye (at least) – body cells that are replaced by newer ones because they age, die and break off from the surface of the retina. These look a bit like translucent UFOs when they float around the fluid in front of the retinal cones, but I am not trying to debunk any one case here! It's just something I have noticed thousands of times!

Flashes of light appear when an eye is inadvertently moved by contact with something outside the body. It is absolutely imperative that this be prevented as much as possible because sight is one of the 'miracles' of the Universe and must be cared for at all costs! Once it's gone for good, it can't always be returned.

However, I have noticed this being done while touching some kind of liquid crystal display, which immediately forms a 'black glow' around a finger. I can't get it to work on my laptop or calculator, but it has occurred somewhere else. The point is that photons of light – or false visual effects can be produced by means other than by intended sources! What appears to be the direct source isn't necessarily the case!

# Hot and Cold Running Light

Only in recent times did I read about one version of the Min Min Lights as being a swarm of small fireflies that have puzzled many people in the past.

Bioluminescence is the ability for life to create light without the heat that we usually associate with it – like light globes, radiators and fire or stars! Now we have Light Emitting Diodes – otherwise known as LEDs, which are made from earth-based chemical combinations to give us several colours.

## **Body of Light**

Synthetically created materials that glow in the dark are definitely not new, having been around for at least several decades! There have been some reports of UFOs that emit light from the skins of crafts – as though the glows are not actually lamps, but something emanating from the bodies of crafts.

Other reports have appeared about light beams extending only so far, then cutting off, which will require a very technical explanation! I still have no idea how that is really possible, but I imagine that photons are programmed or focussed in some way to stop at a certain time (or frequency) after being emitted by some unfamiliar source!

The coating of special chemicals is what creates the glow when an electric current is passed through it.

Making a material that glows instead of installing lamps behind that material is very easy! All that is required to simulate the glowing body of a UFO is to encase an array of LEDs in a block of epoxy resin, just like surfies do to encase polystyrene foam in fibreglass and resin.

What I have been telling people for decades is that electromagnetic radiation at any frequency has the same basic properties. However, "different horses for different courses" still applies! This is also why there is not a lot of difference between the red light of a rainbow in the sky and infrared light next to it – or ultraviolet light on the bottom side of a rainbow!

It's just that our vision is woefully limited in the frequency spectrum, and can be likened to those infinitesimally small penlight torches that Dana Scully and Fox Mulder use in the X-Files! In fact, they are considerably worse off than those massive tubes of batteries that movie theatre attendants (or ushers) carry around in the dark!

Just because the light beams have a very limited coverage of everything that is around them, that doesn't mean there is nothing else out there – and so it is with sound energy.

I have also done this with moving air in an air cannon! What seems like a column of air moving forward is actually a vortex, shaped like a doughnut that is continually rolling itself inside out and outside in!

People who have seen the "Morning Glory" as it rolls its way over the Australian mainland will know a bit of what I am talking about, but this is shaped like a tyre tube filled with air! (At least, that is more natural and healthier than a doughnut!)

Way back in high school in the 1960s, I learned about words that I wasn't supposed to use in front of primary school children. They could have been overcome by something that was ahead of their time – believed to be undeveloped brain cells! However, I have more recently mixed with 6-year-old kids who have been telling me about University stuff!

Also, how can kids develop brain cells unless they are exposed to information, which they have never encountered before? I was usually surprised when over-caring (not necessarily overbearing) mothers were surprised or stepped in at the sound of words their children had never heard of. You could also think of that as friction!

How else could all of this apply to UFOs – or Earth-bound crafts that don't look like anything, which most of the general public are familiar with? Let's start with the nose cone, or the leading edge of any road vehicle or marine vessel, which cuts into the Earth's atmosphere or seas!

I have shown children how the front ends of different boats affect bow waves, using wooden blocks with different shapes. These included a horizontally-flat one and a roof-shaped one – probably two with one having a sharper point than another. Each boat was pulled along a trough of water, taking different times to arrive at the far end because of the surface area and angle in the water!

I don't know of anyone who hasn't seen videos of NASA's space shuttles returning without engine power to Earth – and the brilliant glow of the underside covered with tiles, some of which have been coming off in the heat generated by friction at high speeds in the atmosphere! How do UFOs prevent that? Apart from not having tiles, I have heard about magnetic shields, which are said to be spaced out around the skins of vessels.

How far that it is, I have not yet properly investigated, but as an electrician from the distant past – and playing around with electronics again after a long break from the 1970s, I can tell you that it doesn't take much to create an insulator of electricity! A vacuum or some corrosion can slow down or stop electrons and their wave power from being transferred between two conductive metals or liquids.

Come to think of it, I remember building a UFO detector that I found the instructions for in a 1970s electronics magazine! That was a lot of fun and a bit of valuable experience, but I couldn't test it in the field. Why do you think that happened? Sometime after that, I heard that a university had an earthquake detector that was so sensitive, cars moving around the car park were being registered.

How these tie in with friction, I am not quite sure at the moment, but I do know that everything in this Universe is connected. For cohesion to readily occur, there obviously has to be more of that than friction. I have demonstrated attraction using oil, which contained magnetite, and brought a magnet close to them. This could be unnerving for people who couldn't handle the black oil in the X-Files!

I also love to demonstrate this using two bar magnets on a carpet or mat where there is a lot of friction. You can do the same and be amazed if you lay one magnet down on the carpet, then stand the other up at an angle, near the end of one pole, – like Evil Knievel on the back wheel of his motorbike.

After awhile, you will discover which poles to use close to each other and how far away the balancing magnet must be from the one laying on the carpet. You cannot perform this 'trick' without friction – or with it! If friction didn't exist, the carpet would have no effect, and the magnets would smash into each other.

Another of those 'unwritten' laws of the Universe is that nothing is all one way and not the other, but in various states of existence at various times because of various conditions around it. These include the different forms of energy mentioned in another article, you know – light, heat, sound, magnetism, gravity etc.? Not only that, but one of my favourite quotes variously goes something like "nothing in this Universe ever stays the same" and "nothing is what it appears to be".

## Can You See Me?

#### Who would like to be invisible?

Given the predictability of human nature by movie screenwriters – I don't think that would be a good idea! Look at all the trouble we have heard about from people who said they have been abducted? Many of us would obviously misuse it as much as occupants of UFOs are said to do! Present-day humanity has a long way to go before it can earn the privilege of working alongside the crews of Star Trek missions, hundreds of years from now!

There are some brilliant books around – one being "Sight Unseen" by Budd Hopkins! He wrote the first part of this dual-theme book, with the second part being written by Carol Rainey. She concentrates on hypnotic regression, but invisibility is why I bought the Kindle version. I did so because I have had my own questions and theories about the reports that have been coming in from around the world.

As with everything in this Universe, nothing is fully one way or the other – and light is definitely no different. This book seems to cover everything from the familiar mirage to the alien in the movie, "Predator", where the cloak used is not totally invisible, to partially-transparent and cloudy images that look and act like holograms.

It also describes the way in which cloaking is possible for one secret aircraft by having light wrap around the body of this plane in the same way that starlight is bent through the Earth's atmosphere, enabling us to see stars that are actually behind it. This is not an unusual occurrence as that is similar to what industrial designers see when smoke is introduced into the airflow of a wind tunnel. Moving air will stay close to a surface when passing it.

In easy text form, I can demonstrate this, where the 'vertical lines' and 'parentheses' represent the light folding around the uppercase letter 'O'. The 'hash' character at the top represents a distant object where light is reflected, and ends up on someone's retinas at the bottom. Because the light folds neatly around the letter 'O', all that should be visible are exactly the same photons of light coming from the distant object that is not in a direct line of sight.

These photons would block the letter 'O' – right in front of us if secret government departments do not want the general public to see it! Of course, light being what it is, it radiates in all directions when not being focussed as it is in a laser beam, so the letter 'O' should be invisible from all directions – horizontally and diagonally, at least on this page!

(I can't use the word "problem" here!)

After several years of changing – and cringing at someone's disclosure in the 1990s, I have changed to accept that I can't prove that their disclosure was a figment of their imagination, but they still can't prove that what they were saying actually happened. Therein lies a "problem" – not just one "aspect" of their lives! They can choose to tell people about it and ignore the ridicule by others, or keep quiet for the rest of their lives!

Just seeing a UFO can still be damaging enough when friends get hold of the story, but actually meeting or being experimented on by beings who don't look human would be a nightmare! I can only imagine this, not having any experience in this field. This is why I have thought about the physiology of what we know as aliens, strengthened by many reports – not including the now-believed-to-be hoax of that famous alien autopsy video! There must still be some internal gravity – or magnetic restraints for occupants, as I have also read about.
